Emergency Architecture & Human Rights believes in Architecture that works with and for local communities, with locally-sourced materials, advancing local construction methods and democratic processes as a means to building human rights.

The workshop 1+1=11 is a participatory building seminar where participants have the possibility to learn building techniques, work side by different communities, develop personal skills and work with EAHR team. This experience gives everyone the possibility to build a project useful for a specific community.

The workshop can be developed as a construction laboratory in which we share our knowledge, material's handling composition and resistance by working directly in the building site and engaging with the relative local community. We have previously work with local communities in Denmark, Italy, Jordan and Chile. The Workshop 1+1=11's mission is to train the participants, empower communities, facilitate the development of future resilient communities, building together with EAHR Team the idea that Architecture is a Human Right.

Topics

For this workshop, participants will contribute to forming and building Unicorny camp's pavilion, in Roskilde Festival's DreamCity site, supported by LGBT+Y. The project, in sensible respect to the organization's ethos, requires great attention to creating non binary and gender neutral architecture.

The goal is to intervene on a public space, in Roskilde site, through artistic and architectural actions, seminars and dialogues, in order to improve community spirit, resilience and to create awareness on the latest gender topics society has to address. An intense interactive experience which brings participants from all over the world directly in contact with the LGBT community.

Structure

Workshop 1+1=11 is an on-field practical experience, focused in: experimental self-construction site, theoretical lectures, sustainable techniques and social participation. Every weekend a 2-days-workshop will take place targeted to a community nourishing interests in human rights and/or architecture. During the period of the workshop there will be also some seminars. On Fridays, we are planning short-

seminars presenting different thematics for e.g. the relation between gender and architecture.

The following days are oriented to introduce the attendants to sustainable construction techniques, material's handling composition and resistance. The 6 WE project will result in the construction of a pavilion to be used during Roskilde Festival.

Objectives

1. Provide a pavilion as a common space for LGBT temporary activities during the year.
2. Spreading a sensible understanding of safe developmental environments.
3. Deepen their knowledge about social architecture and social participation.
4. The participation process will raise awareness about LGBT Youth community and non binary architecture.
5. Participants will work side by side with LGBT Youth and EAHR members, where they will learn how to build with their hand and how to work with wood and recycle materials.
